

I was born on 2 January, 1873 and baptised as Marie Frances Therese. I was the youngest of nine children. From a young age, I wanted to serve God as a nun. I was only 14, when I met with Pope Leo XIII on a trip to Rome and pleaded for his approval.

Fun Facts

I'm often called the Little Flower.
I wrote "The Story of a Soul", where I taught about practicing the Little Way.
I and my four sisters were nuns.
Before dying, I promised to spend my
Heaven doing good on earth.
Pope Pius XI declared me a saint.

Cloistered Life

I joined the Carmelite order when I was 15. I served as a sacristan and assistant novice mistress.
I dedicated my life to prayer, to win souls for God until the end of time.
I lived an ordinary life, which became a path to sainthood by the Little Way.

The Little Way

The Little Way is a path of holiness, that helps us completely surrender ourselves as babies in the arms of God our Father. It involves offering everything up to God, through Jesus, as an act of love and sacrifice. It is a way of complete trust in God.

The Holy Angels are servants and messengers of God. They stand before His Throne in Heaven worshipping Him in Adoration, and carry out His message on earth. God assigns an Angel to every human being when they are born, to become their Guardian through life. These are called Guardian Angels.

Jesus tells us that the Angels of children always behold the Face of His Father in Heaven (Matthew 18:10). Psalm 91 says that God has given His Angels charge of us to guard us. Angels are also sent by God to guard nations, churches and communities. Some saints like Padre Pio had great devotion to their Guardian Angel.

My father changed my name to Francesco as he didn't want me to be named after saint John the Baptist.
Growing up, I was wealthy and well liked and desired to become a knight.

Fun Facts

I joined my family business and became a wealthy merchant, but I later disowned everything to follow Jesus. After disowning everything, I lived as a poor beggar, living outside in nature and in harmony with God's creation. I was blessed with the wounds of Christ, called the stigmata.



Mission

I was made a knight to fight for the Crusade, then I had a dream where God told me to return back home. After that dream, I started desiring to know God's will for my life. One day in prayer at San Damiano Church, I heard Christ on the cross tell me to rebuild His Church.

The Gospel Way

I obeyed Jesus' call to rebuild His Church through a life of poverty, preaching the Gospel and teaching others to do the same. Other men joined me and together we formed the Franciscans. Our goal was and remains to live the Gospel in its simplest form.

we have done what was our duty."







I grew up with a very strict father and by the time I was a teenager, I was only interested in fashion and fun.
My father sent me to the convent when I was 16, because he thought I was out of control.

Fun Facts

I became a nun later on in life as I preferred convent life to marriage.
At the convent, I practiced mental prayer and taught others about it too.
Later, I struggled with prayer and stopped praying for many years.
A priest encouraged me to resume praying and when I did, Jesus gave me mystical experiences.

Mission

People accused me of faking my mystical experiences while in prayer. Jesus encouraged me and gave me a desire to make Him my closest friend. I started a new convent for nuns who wanted to be dear friends with Jesus.

Discalded Carmelites

Many people liked me until I decided to live a more strict life as a nun and started the Discalded Carmelites.

I got a lot of trouble everywhere I went as I tried to start up convents.

Our first convent was St. Joseph as I believe in his powerful intercession.

Many women joined me and we set up many convents.

Luke, Evangelist

October 18th



I was a physician who became a follower of Jesus. I lived in the time of the Apostles and was an active disciple in the Early Church.
I wrote the Gospel of Luke and the Book of Acts.

Fun Facts

The Gospel of Luke is often symbolised as an ox or bull.

I am also acknowledged as an artist, for drawing the initial icons of the Christ Child and His Mother Mary.

I'm known as a historian because my writings accurately record details of Christ's birth and the Apostles' encounters.



Missionary Trips

I was a disciple of St. Paul and followed him and our companions on many of his missionary trips.
We sailed by sea to many regions and suffered lots of dangers including shipwreck, but God helped us.

Historical Records

The Gospel I wrote, details accounts of Jesus' early years. It shows how Jesus fulfils the Old Covenant as He is the Great High Priest and Sacrificial Lamb. The Book of Acts details accounts of the Church's early years. It shows the Apostles' encounters after Jesus' Ascension and the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost.

Jesus addressed this parable to those who were convinced of their own righteousness and despised everyone else.

"Two people went up to the temple area to pray; one was a Pharisee and the other was a tax collector.

The Pharisee took up his position and spoke this prayer to himself,

'O God, I thank you that I am not like the rest of humanity -- greedy, dishonest, adulterous -or even like this tax collector. I fast twice a week, and I pay tithes on my whole income.' But the tax collector stood off at a distance and would not even raise his eyes to heaven but beat his breast and prayed,

'O God, be merciful to me a sinner.'

I tell you, the latter went home justified, not the former;

for whoever exalts himself will be humbled, and the one who humbles himself will be exalted."

So let us remember we can always come before Him as His little children, no matter what we have done, to seek His mercy.


Come Holy Spirit

Jude was a son of Cleopas and a relative of Jesus. He was also known by the name Thaddeus.

Fun Facts

Jude wrote the Letter of Jude, found in the New Testament. He is known as the patron of "lost causes". Simon once thought that the Messial would establish an earthly kingdom by physical wars and conquests, the message of Christ's Kingdom was very different to what he expected!





The Letter of Jude

Jude: My letter to the Church, warns about the dangers of a false religion. I asked the faithful to remain steadfast in the truth, and to pray for people who deny Church authority or mock the faith or live careless lives.


Martyrdom
