John 6:37-40


Jesus said to the crowds:

John 2:13-22

Since the Passover of the Jews was near, Jesus went up to Jerusalem.

He made a whip out of cords and drove them all out of the temple area, with the sheep and oxen, and spilled the coins of the money-changers and overturned their tables, and to those who sold doves he said,

His disciples recalled the words of Scripture, Zeal for your house will consume me.

At this the Jews answered and said to him, "What sign can you show us for doing this?"

Jesus answered and said to them, "Destroy this temple and in three days I will raise it up."

The Jews said,
"This temple has been under construction for forty-six years, and you will raise it up in three days?"

But he was speaking about the temple of his Body.

Therefore, when he was raised from the dead, his disciples remembered that he had said this, and they came to believe the Scripture and the word Jesus had spoken.



Luke 21:5-19

While some people were speaking about how the temple was adorned with costly stones and votive offerings,

Jesus said, "All that you see here-the days will come when there will not be left a stone upon another stone that will not be thrown down."

Then they asked him,
"Teacher, when will this happen?
And what sign will there be when all these things are about to happen?"

He answered,
"See that you not be deceived,
for many will come in my name,
saying,

'I am he,' and 'The time has come.'
Do not follow them!

When you hear of wars, do not be terrified; for such things must happen first, but it will not immediately be the end."

Then he said to them,
"Nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom.
There will be powerful earthquakes, famines, and plagues; and awesome sights and mighty signs will come from the sky.

"Before all this happens, however, they will seize and persecute you...

It will lead to your giving testimony. Remember, you are not to prepare what you are to say beforehand, for I myself shall give you a wisdom in speaking that all your adversaries will be powerless to resist or refute.

You will be hated by many because of my name, but not a hair on your head will be destroyed.

By your perseverance you will secure your lives."

Perseverance

Perseverance means "to persevere" - which is to continue going when things are difficult. There is a popular saying, "When the going gets tough, the tough get going."

It means that when things in life get difficult, strong people persevere and never give up.

This is the mindset of the saints and martyrs.

This is the strength that the Holy Spirit has given to them and to us as believers in Christ.

Two men will be out in the field; one will be taken, and one will be left.


Two women will be grinding at the mill; one will be taken, and one will be left.

30 NOVEMBER 2025 1ST SUNDAY OF ADVENT



Come LORD Jesus!



Advent begins today. This is a period of four weeks before Christmas, when we reflect on Jesus' Nativity and His second coming as King! Jesus says that He will come again, and no one knows the day or time when He would arrive. He asks us to "stay awake" and "be prepared". This is only possible if we allow Jesus into our hearts and allow Him to be King of our lives. The more we allow Jesus to reign in us on earth, the more prepared we will be to accept His reign as our Eternal King in Heaven.
