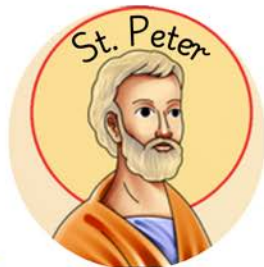

4 JANUARY 2026 THE EPIPHANY OF THE LORD



Matthew 2:1-12

When Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judea, in the days of King Herod, behold, magi from the east arrived in Jerusalem, saying, "Where is the newborn king of the Jews?"

We saw his star at its rising and have come to do him homage."

When King Herod heard this, he was greatly troubled, and all Jerusalem with him.

Assembling all the chief priests and the scribes of the people, he inquired of them where the Christ was to be born. They said to him, "In Bethlehem of Judea, for thus it has been written through the prophet:

And you, Bethlehem, land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; since from you shall come a ruler, who is to shepherd my people Israel."

Then Herod called the magi secretly and confirmed from them the time of the star's appearance.

He sent them to Bethlehem and said, "Go and search diligently for the child. When you have found him, bring me word, that I too may go and do him homage."

After their visit with the king they set out.

And behold, the star that they had seen at its rising went ahead of them, until it came and stopped over the place where the child was.

They were overjoyed at seeing the star, and on entering the house they saw the child with Mary his mother.

They prostrated themselves and did him homage.

Then they opened their treasures and offered him gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh.

And having been warned in a dream not to return to Herod, they departed for their country by another way.

I did not know him, but the reason why I came baptising with water was that he might be made known to Israel.”

John testified further, saying, “I saw the Spirit come down like a dove from heaven and remain upon him.

I did not know him, but the one who sent me to baptise with water told me,

‘On whomever you see the Spirit come down and remain, he is the one who will baptise with the Holy Spirit.’

Now I have seen and testified that he is the Son of God.”

The Son of God

John the Baptist's testimony about Jesus was life changing for those who heard and believed him. Indeed two of John's own disciples, Andrew and Philip, left John that same day and began to follow Jesus. John lost everything and he was happy to, as He revealed Jesus not just as the Son of Mary, but as the Son of God and the Lamb of God!

If Jesus was simply the Son of Mary and Joseph, then He was only human and could not save us. But as the Son of God, He is the image of the invisible God, He is the WORD made flesh, He is our Saviour. Jesus is true God and true Man.

25 JANUARY 2026 3RD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Matthew 4:12-23

When Jesus heard that John had been arrested, he withdrew to Galilee.

He left Nazareth and went to live in Capernaum by the sea, in the region of Zebulun and Naphtali, that what had been said through Isaiah the prophet might be fulfilled:

Land of Zebulun and land of Naphtali,
the way to the sea, beyond the Jordan,
Galilee of the Gentiles,
the people who sit in darkness have
seen a great light,
on those dwelling in a land
overshadowed by death
light has arisen.

From that time on, Jesus began to preach and say,
"Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."

As he was walking by the Sea of Galilee, he saw two brothers, Simon who is called Peter, and his brother Andrew, casting a net into the sea; they were fishermen.

He said to them,
"Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men."

At once they left their nets and followed him.

He walked along from there and saw two other brothers, James, the son of Zebedee, and his brother John. They were in a boat, with their father Zebedee, mending their nets.

He called them, and immediately they left their boat and their father and followed him.

He went around all of Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom, and curing every disease and illness among the people.

Fishers of Men

We might think that He called His disciples because they were perfect. But the scripture shows that they were ordinary men who needed to repent from sin.

And His disciples followed Him because they saw Him as their GREAT LIGHT!
